#4553 Ord. 18-036 Authorize the Issuance of the City's General Obligation Bonds or a General Obligation Anticipation Note, in Order to Provide the Funds Necessary to Finance Streets Repairs and Improvements of Various Streets and Roadways Located within the City Limits; Providing for the Sale of the Bonds or the Note; and Authorizing Other Necessary Action (**Ordinance defeated July 12, 2018 to be Reconsidered**)

Synopsis: *This Ordinance is being presented by Administration for Council's review and approval. This Ordinance authorizes the issuance of up to \$5,000,000 aggregate principal amount of General Obligation Bonds (the "Bonds") and up to \$5,000,000 aggregate principal amount of a General Obligation Bond Anticipation Note (Street Repairs Project), Series 2018 in order to provide permanent and temporary financing, respectively, for street repairs and improvements of various streets and roadways located within the city limits and to pay the costs associated with issuance of the Bonds or the Note. The estimated issuance costs from the issuance of the Bonds or Note is expected to be approximately \$15,000.*
