#4853 An Ordinance to Authorize and Approve a Contract Between the City of

Wilmington and Teladoc Health, Inc. for Telehealth Services (1st & 2nd Reading)

Synopsis: This Ordinance is being presented by the Administration for Council's review and

annual price.

Juneteenth to City Employee Holidays with Pay (1st & 2nd Reading)

Synopsis: This Ordinance is being presented by City Council for Council's review and

approval. This Ordinance amends Chapter 40 of the City Code, Section 40-332(a), by permanently adding Juneteenth, also referred to as Freedom Day, to the list of City employee holidays with pay to commemorate the abolition of

slavery on June 19, 1865, the day that the news of the Emancipation

Proclamation finally reached some of the last people in America still held in bondage. The Ordinance shall be deemed effective as of October 1, 2020.
